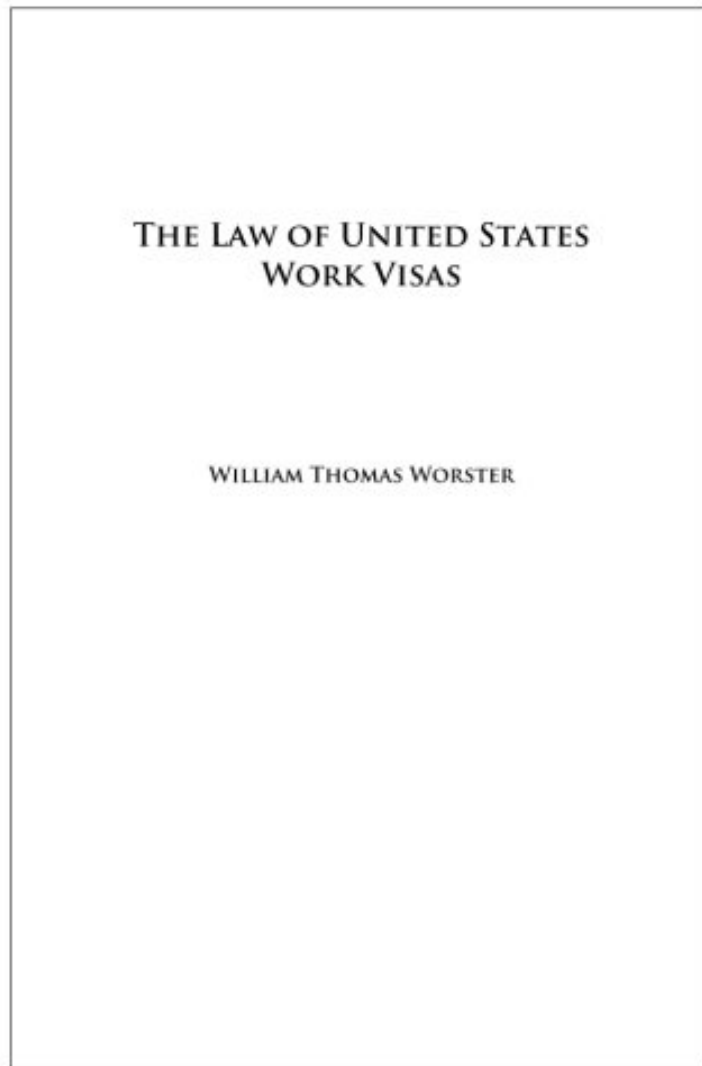

This book is a guide to US immigration law concerning employment-based visas and immigration for the Human Resources professional or the sophisticated immigrant who wishes to understand the process better. Immigrants and

HR professionals trust lawyers to protect them and prepare their paperwork correctly, but this book seeks to help them assert ownership of their immigration process. They will learn why the lawyer is making certain recommendations and how to process works. As a result, the immigrant or corporate professional can better plan their immigration strategy. In the first two chapters there is an overview of the basic concepts of employment-based immigration and the employer sanctions regime. Then, in the subsequent chapters, the book discusses each of the major types of work visas in turn, H-1B, E-1 and E-2, TN, L-1A and L-1B, etc. In the final chapters, it provides a short discussion of permanent residency and labor certification, important for this book only insofar as many immigrants and employers are concurrently pursuing this status. This book does not discuss family-based immigration or refugee status. It focuses on employment-based immigration and provides employers and immigrants the information they need.
