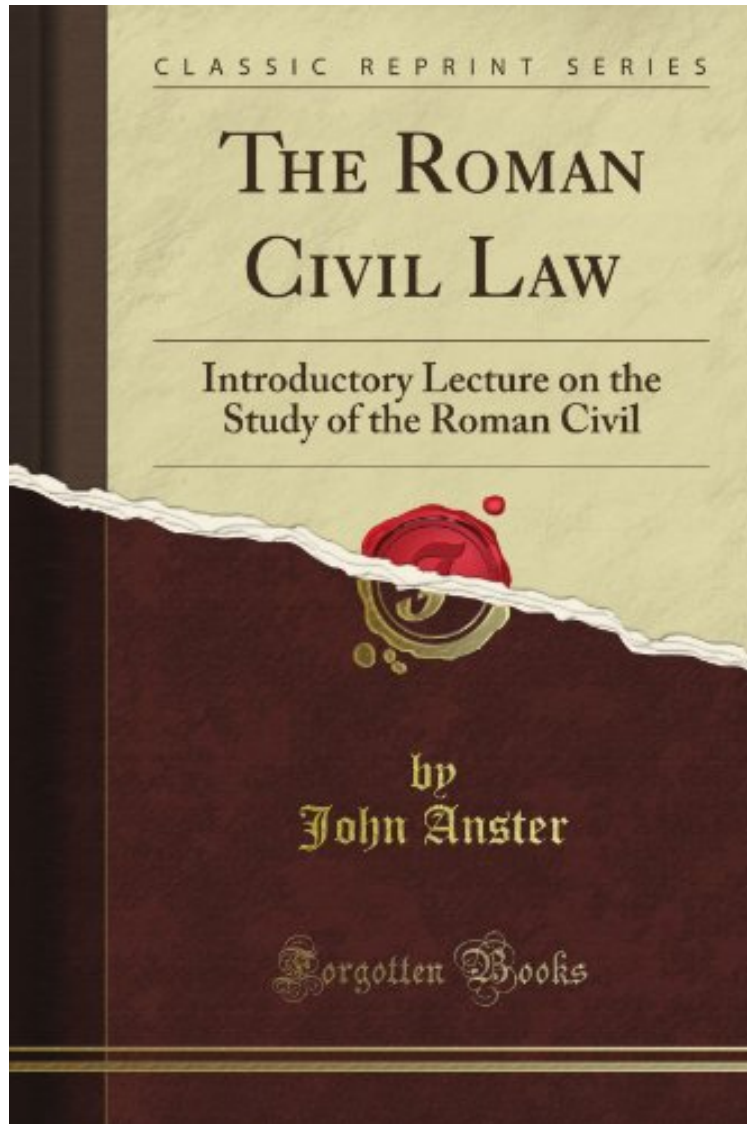

To obtain credit for the second year as law students, they must attend three Terms of the lectures of the Professor of Feudal and English Law, and pass an examination as before, at the end of Trinity Term, in the subjects prescribed by the Professor. 5. Students who comply with the foregoing regulations will be considered as law students of the University, and entitled to the same privileges in their Senior Sophister year which have been already given to other professional students. 6. The Law Professors shall give a joint certificate to such students as have attended for two years the lectures, and passed the examinations required by the foregoing regulations.
